#### I. Beholding God's Glory (John 17:24, 5, 22)

- A. God's desire is to reveal Himself
- **B.** Whenever God appears we behold His glory (Acts 7:2; John 1:14; Eph. 1:17)

### C. God's testimonial becoming more explicit and clear-cut over time

- 1. In the time of the Old Testament
  - a. In creation with man as its focus (Rom. 1:18-23; Psalm 8:5-7)
  - b. In His speaking to men and His acts (Exo. 16:10; Isa. 40:4-5)
  - c. In His dwelling place among men (Gen. 40:34; 1Kings 8:11)
- During the age of the New Covenant (New Testament)
  - a. In Jesus Christ (John 1:14, 18; John 5:36; 14:9-10)
  - b. In His church (1Tim. 3:15-16; Eph. 1:22-23; 3:9-10, 21)
- 3 In the coming age in the New Jerusalem (Rev. 21:2, 10-11)

## **D.** We are predestined for the testimonial of His glory (1.Petr. 5:10; 2Pet. 1:3)

- 1. Our experience already today (Hebr. 2:10; John 17:22; Phil. 4:19; Eph. 1:18; 3:16)
- 2. Our future hope (Col. 1:27; 2Thess. 2:13-14)

#### E. The effect

- 1. We are being transformed into His image (2Cor. 3:18)
- 2. For the world to know and believe (John 17:20-23)
- 3. Creation is to be restored (Rom. 8:19-22)

# II. The Mystery of Godliness: God is Manifested in the Flesh (1Tim. 3:16)

#### A. Christ, the Father's focus and His good pleasure

- 1. The Father is in him and he is in the Father (John 14:10-11; Isa. 9:6)
- 2. Knowing the Son and the Father (John 17:3; 1John 5:20; Eph.1:17; Phil. 3:10)

#### B. The life of Jesus on earth

- 1. As a man manifesting and expressing God (John 1:17; John 14:8ff; Hebr. 1:3)
- 2. Not of this world (John 8:23; John 17:14, 16; Col. 2:8)
- 3. In perfect oneness with the Father (John 10:30; Col. 2:9; John 8:29)
- 4. Not a behavior but by God's life (John 1:4; John 5:19; John 8:28)

## C. The oneness between the Father and the Son is a blessing for the whole universe

- 1. We behold the Father and life is manifested (John 1:14; Col. 1:15; 1.John 1:1-2)
- 2. Grace and truth came or (became real) through Him (John 1:17; 14:6)

- **III. Jesus Includes us in this Oneness** (John 14:1-6; John 17:11; Phil. 2:9-10; Acts 4:12; Hebr. 2:9-10)
  - **A.** By His work in the flesh: death and resurrection (John 12:24-26; 2Kor. 5:14-17)
  - **B.** As the Spirit of life in us the new creation (2Cor. 5:17; Gal. 6:15; 1Petr. 1:3)
    - 1. In the name of Jesus salvation and deliverance (Acts 2:21; 3:14-16; 4:12; John 17:11-12)
    - 2. In the word of life light and truth (John 17:8, 17)

#### C. The outcome: Jesus brings together

- 1. Being united in His name (Acts 1:14; 2:42-44, 47)
- 2. A glorious church (Eph. 5:27; John 17:20-23)

### D. Our decision: a purpose of heart

(Acts 11:23-26)

- 1. The Lord is waiting for our consent (Deut. 30:14-20; Psalm 110:3; 119:108)
  - a. A landmark decision: faith and baptism (Acts 2:37-41; 2Pet. 1:10-11)
  - b. A daily decision: walking in Christ (Col. 2:6-7)
  - c. Coming to the word (Luk. 6:47-48)
- 2. A commitment to build up God's dwelling place (Psalm 132:4-5)
- 3. God working in us to will and to do (Phil. 2:13)

### IV. The Secret of Unity – Abiding in Christ (John 17:20-26; 15:1-8)

### A. We need a revelation concerning our standing in Christ

- 1. Our unity is possible only when we are made one with Him (John 17:12, 21, 23, 24, 26)
- 2. The image of the vine and the branches: Life flowing in us enabling us to bear fruit to the effect of unity (John 15:1-8; Gal. 5:22-23)
- 3. Abiding in Christ, as we are already in Him (John 17:24; 1Cor. 1:30; Eph. 2:6; Psalm 73:23)

#### B. How do we abide in Christ?

- 1. The cleansing work of the Father as the vinedresser by His word and His chastisement (John 15:2-3; Hebr. 12:9-10)
- 2. The Spirt, the anointing teaching us (John 16:13; 1John 2:27)
- 3. Irrespective of feelings based on the word, by faith, in spirit (2Cor. 3:16-18; 4:18; Hebr. 12:1-2; Micah 7:7)
- 4. Being joined to the Lord (1Cor. 6:17; Rom. 8:5-6; 10:12-13; Col. 3:1-2; 1Thess. 5:17; 2Tim. 3:14-17)

#### C. Abiding in the love of Christ (John 15:9-11)

- 1. As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in my love (John 15:9-11)
- 2. Love edifies (1Cor. 8:1; Eph. 4:15-16)

#### V. Our Sanctification for Unity

(John 17:17-19; Eph. 3:17-19; 4:1-4)

#### A. Knowing Christ within us

- 1. Christ in us is our hope of glory (Col. 1:27)
- 2. Inner oneness = oneness with the Lord (John 14:20; 17:3; Eph. 3:16)
- 3. Knowing Christ enables us to comprehend Him together with all the saints (Eph. 3:17-19)

#### B. With Faith and love for God and the Saints

- 1. Experiencing the Lord in order to love the saints (Phlm. 5; 1John 2:10)
- 2. Faith and love belong together (Phil. 1:6; 1Cor. 13:1ff)
- 3. Without love there is no unity
- 4. Every member of the body is essential and important (1Cor. 12)
- 5. Our being built up in love is a vital issue to the Lord (2Petr. 1:4-7)

#### C. Unity through the Spirit

- 1. The concern of the Lord in John 17: Faith and oneness (John 17:8, 11, 20-23)
- 2. Being built up as a dwelling for God in the spirit (Eph. 2:22; Mt. 16:15-18, 22-24)
- 3. United, our access to the Father is unimpaired and without middle walls (Eph. 2:18-19, 14-15)

#### D. Holiness as the Fruit of the Spirit for Unity

- 1. What does "holy" mean for God? (Lev. 19:2-4, 9-18, 34-36)
- 2. Holiness is the basic substance for unity
- 3. Sanctification happens by touching the triune God (John 17:17)
- 4. Sanctification brings us to completion (2Cor. 7:1; 1Thess 5:23)

# VI. Baptized into one Body and made to drink of one Spirit

### **A.** Reconciled in one body by the cross (Eph. 2:16)

#### B. Our status after baptism

- 1. The old self is crucified with Him and we are dead to sin (Rom. 6:6-7)
- 2. Baptized into one body (1Cor. 12:13)
- 3. Knowing the Spirit (1Cor. 2:10, 14-16; Gal. 5:25)

### C. Our experience of the cross leads to completion in unity (John 17:23)

- 1. The unity of the body is practical in the local church (Acts 2:41-42, 46; 1Cor. 12:15-26)
- 2. Each and every saint is vital to the body (1Cor. 12:7-8, 15, 21, 25; Eph. 4:16)
- 3. The natural self is crucified. Treating all that hinders and destroys unity (1Cor. 1:12-13; Gal. 2:19-21; 1Cor. 2:2; Rom. 15:7; Phil. 2:3-4; Phil. 4:2; Gal. 2:14)

### **D.** Making every effort to keep the unity of the spirit (Eph. 4:3)

- 1. We are all saturated in one Spirit and drink of one Spirit (1Cor. 12:13; John 7:37-39)
- 2. The Lord promises the blessing: eternal life (Ps. 133)
- 3. Christ is the head. (Col. 3:18-19)
- 4. Our hearts are knit together (Col. 2:2; Eph. 4:16; 1Cor. 12:26)

#### VII. God's Testimonial: the Unity of the Local Church

#### **A.** God's will: Jesus Christ (Rom. 8:32; 1Cor. 1:30)

- 1. Prophesies concerning the cross (John 1:29, 36; 11:50-52)
- 2. Earthly living and dying in oneness with the Father (John 5:19; Lk. 22:42)
- 3. For the unity of the believers (John 10:11, 16-17)
- 4. His Prayer according to God's will in John 17 is fulfilled
- 5. The Resurrected as the Spirit builds His glorious churches in unity, each at its locality, (Acts, from chap. 2; Eph. 5:25-27) and shepherds them until the end (Acts 8:1; 13:1; Rom. 1:7; Gal. 1:2; Rev. 1:11 3:22; 22:16)

### B. Attacks of the enemy from without and within against holiness and unity

- 1. Prophesies of the Lord (Mt. 16:18-19, 23-25)
- 2. Experiences of the church in Jerusalem
- 3. Paulus' warnings and prophesies (Acts 20:29-30)

### **C.** Division within the church at Corinth (1Cor. chap. 1-4)

### D. Today's testimony of unity through the local church

- 1. A testimony against the world and religion
- 2. Before the principalities and powers of heaven (Eph. 3:10-11)
- 3. For the Lord: His Church, His Body, the fullness, through the Unity in Spirit (Eph. 1:22-23; Eph. 4:1-6)

### E. The church of the first love to the Lord and to the saints (Rev. 2:4-5; 1John 4:16)

#### **VIII. The perfect Unity – the New Jerusalem** (Rev. 21)

#### A. The goal of God's acts

- 1. Rule over the earth (Gen. 1:26; Rev. 2:26-27)
- 2. The bride (Rev. 21:2)

#### **B.** Division ends with Babylon (Rev. 17 und 18)

- 1. Abandoning the first love
- 2. Mingling with the world
- 3. The works and teachings of the Nicolaitians
- 4. The teaching of Jezebel
- 5. Becoming lukewarm

#### **C.** The golden lampstands (Rev. 1:20; Ex. 25:31-39)

- 1. Each local church = a golden Lampstand
  - a. The light of the world (Mt. 5:14-16; Rev. 21:24)
  - b. Formed from one piece of purified gold
  - c. One God one expression one testimonial
- 2. The local churches are independent and yet one among themselves
  - a. Christ, walking among the churches (Rev. 1:13)
  - b. The Spirit speaks to all churches (Rev. 2:7)

#### **D.** The completion – the New Jerusalem

(Rev. 21:2, 10-11)

- 1. The bride of the Lamb
- 2. Heavenly, new, displaying God's glory
- 2. She is heavenly, new and possesses the glory of God.
